FOOD EXPO 2025 (8–10 March 2025, Athens): Our project took center stage at one of the largest food industry events in Southeast Europe. Partners from SEVT, NKUA, ELGO-DIMITRA and CIHEAM-IAMM led an impactful workshop showcasing recent advances in sustainable food technologies. Attendees sampled innovative yogurt and cheese enriched with bioactive compounds.

Forward Green Expo (13–15 March 2025, Thessaloniki): At this dynamic expo, our partners from EKPIZO engaged stakeholders from research, industry, and civil society to explore joint solutions for reducing food waste and building a more resilient Mediterranean food system.

Surrounded by producers and consumers passionate about nutrition, EXCEL4MED raised awareness about sustainable practices and the role of consumers in food system transformation.

Inspiring Young Minds

As part of our outreach efforts, we have continuously introduced circular economy principles to students from Malta and Greece through interactive, hands-on activities!

In Malta, workshops were held at San Anton School Zebbiegħ (30 January), Żejtun Primary (16 April), St. Edward's College (9 May), Primary School Għarb in Gozo (16 May), St Monica School Birkirkara (20 May) and St Thomas More Tarxien Primary (26 May). Led by our partners Malta Enterprise, Mgarr Farms, Koperattivi Malta, the University of Malta, the Malta Food Agency and the Malta Chamber of Commerce, these sessions explored how food waste like orange peels can be transformed into valuable resources.

Meanwhile in **Greece**, our partners from EKPIZO visited the **81st Elementary School of Athens (16 May)**, where students learned how everyday food waste can contribute to sustainable nutrition through green technologies.

The young learners showed a natural interest in how science, innovation and circular thinking can help solve global challenges.

Their curious questions and eager participation made it clear: they understand the importance of sustainability!
